

## Farm Location Form

This form is not required but may be useful when operating a farm vehicle under the Virginia exemptions from registration for farm vehicles, known as Farm Use.

Feel free to use this form to list all of your farm field addresses or parcel ID numbers to make easy reference if asked by law enforcement to supply such.

Beginning July 1, 2017 any law enforcement officer may require the person operating the Farm Use vehicle under §§ 46.2-665, 46.2-666, and 46.2-670 of the Code of Virginia, to provide the address or parcel ID number of lands owned or leased to their farm. You may find it helpful to keep a copy in each Farm Use vehicle

§§ 46.2-665, 46.2-666, and 46.2-670 of the Code of Virginia, includes “Any law-enforcement officer may require any person operating a vehicle, trailer, or semitrailer and claiming the exemption provided pursuant to this section to provide, upon request, the address of the lands owned or leased by the vehicle's owner for agricultural or horticultural purposes. If such address is unavailable or unknown, the law-enforcement officer may require such person to provide the real property parcel identification number of such lands.” 7/1/2017
