## **APPLICATION RULES AND REGULATIONS**

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#### Qualifications

The purpose of the contest is to recognize a young agriculturist for his/her interest and achievements in agriculture and provide him/her with an opportunity to serve as an ambassador for agriculture and Farm Bureau.

#### All contestants must:

- Be a member of Virginia Farm Bureau
- Be 18 years of age or have not reached their 24<sup>th</sup> birthday by the deadline date for the application.
- Complete an application along with all other components attached. Submit it signed by the county Farm Bureau Women's Chair and County President by the deadline date.

## **Competition Process**

- In the case of multiple applicants in a county, the winner will be determined by an Ambassador contest in that county to determine which applicant will be the representative at the VFB Women's Spring Conference.
- Each county Farm Bureau is responsible for it's contestant's expenses incurred during the VFB Women's Spring Conference.
- A 5 x 7 <u>color picture</u> or a digital photo (at least 1500 x 2100 pixels) of the contestant MUST be submitted or emailed to <u>women@vafb.com</u> or accompany the application, and both must be submitted to the Women's & Young Farmer Department by the deadline. <u>Deadline for application and photo is December 31 of year prior to competition.</u> Failure to meet this deadline will result in disqualification of the county contestant.
- Each contestant should be prepared for an interview with a panel of judges.
- Each contestant is expected to develop, present and defend an agriculture related activity platform or project he/she will carry out during his/her tenure, if chosen Virginia Farm Bureau Ambassador, at the VFB Women's Spring Conference in March. The platform presentation may not exceed three minutes in length and will be presented in front of an audience at the conference.
- Former state contest winners are not eligible to compete.

### **Judging Criteria**

• 50% of score: Initial Interview: professional appearance, composure and question responses

• 25% of score: Farm Bureau Essay component

• 25% of score: Content and delivery of platform presentation

#### **Awards**

- The winner will be announced at the annual VFB Women's Spring Conference. He/she will receive a \$2,000 cash award divided into two payments. A report on their platform progress with be given at the conclusion of their term during the Women's Spring Conference.
- First Runner-up receives a cash award of \$500.
- All other finalists competing at the VFB Women's Spring Conference will each receive \$200 for their efforts.
- Virginia Farm Bureau Ambassador will be provided an itinerary of appearances and speaking engagements that are scheduled prior to his/her term. The winner <u>WILL BE</u> expected to attend each event. Expenses will be covered by VFBF.
- Virginia Farm Bureau Ambassador's conference expenses will be reimbursed to the county by Virginia Farm Bureau, following the VFB Women's Spring Conference.
